

## Grade and Repertoire Expectations:

### FMFNS [Provincials]

### FCMF [Nationals]

1. Solo competitors in the Nova Scotia Kiwanis Music Festival may be recommended to FMFNS' Provincial Music Festival as follows:
  - a) Solo Competitors 18 years and under may be recommended to -
    - **Non-Competitive Education Stream:** classes with Junior level repertoire, RCM grades 4 – 7 required **OR**
    - **Developing Artist Stream:** classes with Intermediate level repertoire, RCM grades 8 – 10 required.
  - b) Solo Competitors 30 years and under may be recommended to the **Emerging Artist Stream:** a Virtual or Live Festival with Senior/Advanced Repertoire beyond RCM Grade 10 required.
2. Bands and Choirs may be recommended to the Provincial Music Festival's Virtual **Recorded Stream**.
3. Junior, Intermediate and Advanced/Senior level Composers may be recommended to the Provincial Music Festival's **Composer Stream**.
4. For complete and up-to-date information relating to all classes listed in 1 – 3 above, teachers and competitors **MUST** refer to the current Syllabus found on the websites of the FMFNS and the FCMF.
5. Please note: The Provincial Music Festival is the gateway for Nova Scotia competitors to be recommended to the FCMF's National Music Festival held each year in August.
